Deleah Rose (Dee) Schroeder Koch, 46, of Evansville, went to be with the Lord on Sunday, March 26, 2006 at Deaconess Hospital surrounded by her loving family.

Dee was born February 22, 1960 in Evansville. She graduated from North Posey High School in 1978 and the University of Evansville with a Bachelor of Liberal Sciences degree. She had worked at Berry Plastics, DSM Plastics and was currently employed at Omni Plastics. She was a member and secretary of the local chapter of the Society of Plastic Engineers.

She was a lifetime member of Zion-Lippe United Church of Christ, where she was very active. She was a member of the Zion Women's Guild and the Senior Choir and was currently serving as Worship chairperson of the Zion Church Council. 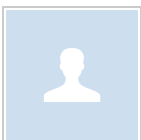
