



Delores Helfrich Schroeder

December 27, 1932 - August 12, 2025

With sadness in our hearts, Delores Mary Weinzapfel Helfrich Schroeder, age 92, passed peacefully at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus on Tuesday, August 12, 2025, surrounded by her loving family.

Delores was born on December 27, 1932, in Anderson, Indiana, to the late Alphons and Elma (Bassemier) Weinzapfel. She was a proud member of the Mater Dei class of 1950, the first graduating class of Mater Dei High School. She maintained a close friendship with many of her classmates. Delores worked at Old National Bank, Reis Catering, Woolco, Hills, and Venture, but her most important job was being a mother to her children. Delores was a faithful member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County; she was active in her prayer group and the Cursillo movement and volunteered her time to distribute communion to the homebound members of her church.
