



Dennis "D.G." Fehrenbacher

November 19, 1948 - March 24, 2017

Dennis G. "D.G." Fehrenbacher, age 68, of Grand Rivers, KY, formerly of Evansville, passed away Friday, March 24, 2017 at Deaconess Hospital.

Denny was born November 19, 1948 in Evansville to the late Gilbert and Alberta (Benkert) Fehrenbacher. He retired from Fehrenbacher Cabinet Company; he was the owner and operator of DG Rentals in Grand Rivers, KY and was a former teacher at Central High School. Denny was a former member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County and a member of St. Anthony of Padua Catholic Church in Grand Rivers. He was very active in prison ministry and an active volunteer to benefit Haiti, having made 10 mission trips to Haiti. Denny was a proud member and past president of the Westside Nut Club. He was an avid golfer and boater and held a marine Captain's license. He also enjoyed traveling back to Germany, the homeland of his ancestors.

Surviving Denny are his daughter, Cori (Joe) Greulich and son, Todd Fehrenbacher, both of Evansville; grandchildren, Clark and Chase Fehrenbacher; sisters, Joan (George) David and Carol (Harvey) Klenck, both of Evansville; Betty (Jerry) David of Bloomington and MaryAnn (Mark) Miller of Evansville and brothers, Gary (Ruth Burke) Fehrenbacher and Bob (Mary K.) Fehrenbacher, both of Evansville and Dr. John (Cindy) Fehrenbacher of Indianapolis, IN. He also leaves behind a special friend, Claudette Branson;

many nieces, nephews, cousins, aunts, uncles and friends.

There will be a Mass of Christian Burial held at 10:00 A.M. on Wednesday, March 29, 2017 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County, Rev. Eugene Schroeder officiating. Burial will follow in the St. Joseph Church Cemetery.
