Dewey Boylls, age 73, passed away Sunday, June 12, 2016 after a long bout with cancer.

He retired in 1999 from Indiana Bell-Ameritech after 34 years of service. An avid softball player, he played on multiple State and National Championship teams. He was named first team All-American at first base and was inducted into the ASA Softball Hall of Fame in 1998.

He loved most spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren.

Dewey was preceded in death by his parents, his brother, Mark Boylls and his sister, Cynthia Hudson.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 52 years, Earleen, two sons, Doug (Kelly) of Elberfeld and Mike (Amy) of Glendora, CA.
