Dolores J. Horn, 94, of Evansville, passed away peacefully on Friday, March 27, 2026, at Solarbron.

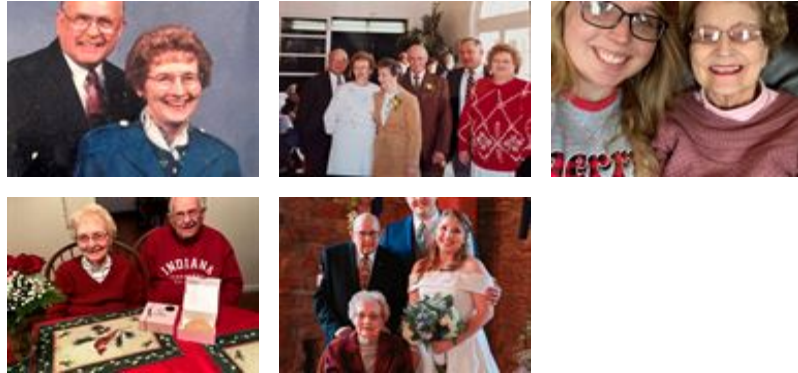
