



Dolores Marie (Hoefling) Niemeier

Dolores (Hoefling) Niemeier, 90, of Evansville, passed away on Monday, April 6, 2009 at the VNA Charlier Hospice Center due to complications from a stroke.

Dolores was born on August 25, 1918 to George and Elizabeth (Maurer) Hoefling. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County and along with her husband Jim, was inducted into the Evansville Diocese Brute Society. 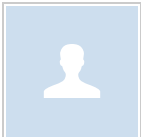

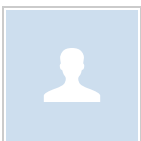
