Donald Lee Schneider, age 74, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, March 23, 2010, at St. Mary's Medical Center.

Mr. Schneider had worked at the University of Evansville in the maintenance department for 36 years, before his retirement in 1997. He served in the United States Army in Korea and was a member of St. Agnes Catholic Church. Don was a country music fan and was especially fond of guitar music. He had his guitar autographed by his favorite guitarist, Chet Atkins. During the 1950's and 60's, Don played in a band that performed at local clubs.

Surviving are his wife of 48 years, Ann (Rollett) Schneider; his daughter, Connie (Don) Coomes of Evansville; his son, Donald (Susan) Schneider, Jr. of Loveland, OH and seven grandchildren, Jason (Leah), Jeremy and Jonathan Coomes and Lauren, Kirsten, Evan and Ethan Schneider. Also surviving are Don's uncle and aunt, Edwin and Margie Schneider of Jasper, IN and his aunt, Bert Harris of Huntingburg, IN.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Victor and Marie (Fischer) Schneider.
