



## Donald E. Scherer

January 3, 1933 - September 11, 2010

Donald E. Scherer, age 77, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, September 11, 2010 at Deaconess Hospital.

Don had been the owner and operator of Scherer Monument, having gone to work for his father in the family business in 1966 before taking over in 1973. Prior to working for his father, Don worked as a butcher for 14 years. He was a member of the Hadi Shrine, Scottish Rite, Evansville Masonic Lodge #64, the Oriental Band, ARAB Patrol and the Select 34th Group. He was also a member of St. Paul's United Church of Christ on Michigan Street, the Kennel Club, USI Varsity Club and a 1954 graduate of Reitz High School. Don enjoyed cooking, barbequing and bass fishing.

Surviving Don are his son and daughter-in-law, Ron and Judy Scherer of Haubstadt and their four children, Ryan Donald (Anne) Scherer, Stephanie (Andy) Ragozzino, Rhonda (Nathan) Wilzbacher and Kristy Scherer and six great grandchildren. Don was preceded in death by his wife of 36 years, Lee (Egbert) Scherer in January of 2009 and his parents, Edgar and Alvina (Schauss) Scherer.
