Dorothy A. (Kasbohm) Mirando, 84, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, May 11, 2006 at Deaconess Hospital. She was born in Evansville, Indiana on August 22, 1921 and was the daughter of Lydia (Winiger) and Herman Kasbohm.

She was a member of Central United Methodist Church where she belonged to the US Class. She also taught children's Sunday School for over 30 years.
