Dustin Michael Beal, age 30, passed away Sunday, January 11, 2015.

Dustin was a 10 year veteran of the United States Army Reserves and served tours in both Iraq and Kuwait. He was a 2003 graduate of Mater Dei High School where he competed in both football and wrestling. Dustin had worked as a sheet metal worker and was a 10 year member of Sheet Metal Worker's Local #20. He was also a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church.

Surviving Dustin are two sons, Branson Michael Beal and Brady Robert Beal; his parents, Ronald and Wilma (Draper) Beal; his former wife and mother of his children, Jenjer Beal; his grandmother, Marilyn Beal and half-sister, Tiffini Morton, all of Evansville. Also surviving are many caring aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his grandfather, Billy Beal and grandparents, Cecil and Ollie Draper.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, January 17, 2015 at Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Rev. Claude Burns officiating. Entombment with military rites will follow in St. Joseph Cemetery.
