Edgar Ray “Ed” Hertel, 86, of Evansville, passed away peacefully on Wednesday, July 22, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family.

Ed was born April 19, 1934 in Evansville to the late Valentine and Cecilia (Weber) Hertel. He retired from the Evansville Fire Department and after 20 years of service and St. Mary’s Medical Center as the Director of Security after 20 years. He was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church and a veteran of the United States Army, serving during the Korean War.

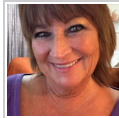

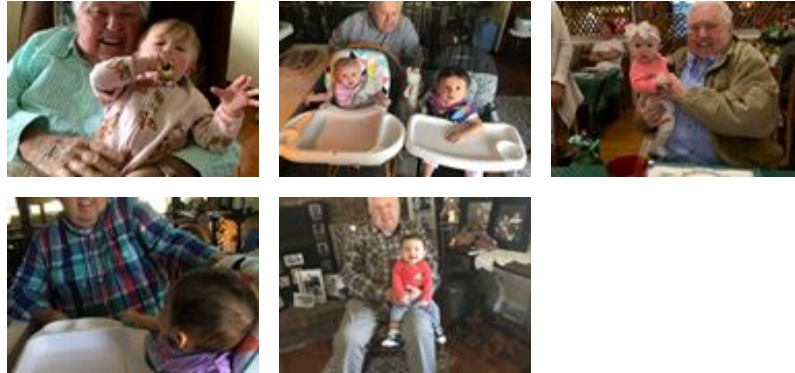
