Edna Mae Schneider, 99, of Poseyville, passed away at River Oaks in Princeton on Tuesday, October 13, 2020.

Edna Mae was born December 20, 1920 in Vanderburgh County, IN to the late Leo and Katherine (Elpers) Schmitt.
