Edward F. Sammet, 98, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, May 20, 2017 at the Heritage Center.

Ed was born July 25, 1918 to the late Joseph A. and Julia (Schenk) Sammet. He worked for Swift Packing Company and Emge Packing Company. Ed was a veteran of the United States Army serving during World War II and a life member of VFW Post #1114. Ed was also a member of Holy Redeemer Catholic Church, the Holy Redeemer Clabber Club and St. Philip Conservation Club. He was inducted into the Brute` Society in 2005 for his service to his parish and the Diocese of Evansville.
