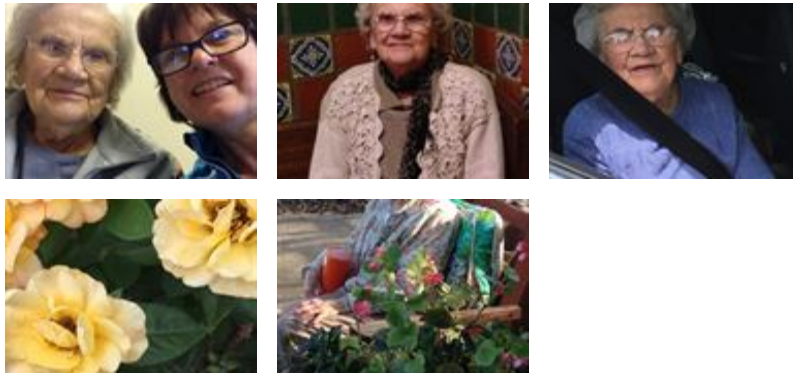
“ To Karen and the Family,
