E. Jane "Mama Fitz" Fitzgerald, died Sunday, August 13, 2006 at her home after a brief illness.

Jane was the daughter of Columbia and Foley Roberts.

She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, and the Daughters of Isabella. She was an insurance agent and a long time resident of Evansville's West Side, since the death of her husband, Gerald J. Fitzgerald in 1972.

Jane graduated from Memorial High School and attended Evansville College where she was a member of Gamma Epsilon Sigma Sorority (now Chi Omega Sorority). When Gerald returned from the South Pacific in 1945, they were married in Henderson, KY.
