Elizabeth Ann “Betty” Coulter, 90, of Evansville, passed away peacefully at her home on Tuesday, December 30, 2025, surrounded by family.

Betty was born on January 11, 1935, in Evansville to the late Raymond and Mary Ethel (Montgomery) Schmidt.
