



Ervin O. Lamble

August 14, 1915 - March 25, 2008

Ervin Oscar Lamble was born to a father who was a second generation American and a mother who was a first generation American over 92 years ago. They settled in Evansville, Indiana, to live a better life and raise a large Catholic family steeped in family values. His father, Joseph Lamble, was a son of a French immigrant father and a Swiss immigrant mother, and his mother, Effie Reiter Lamble, was an Austrian immigrant.

He was third child born to his parents. He was born on August 14, 1915, and his siblings were Joseph, Leo, Anton, Marie, Margaret, Odelia, and Virginia Lamble. His father died during the Depression when Ervin was sixteen years old, and he went to work to help support his mother and his younger sisters. His mother lived until 1950.

He married his only sweetheart, Margaret Wingert, on January 29, 1937 at St. Anthony Catholic Church. They had nine children and were married for 66 years. Their family grew to 20 grandchildren and 22 great grandchildren.

Ervin and Margaret were faithful members of St. Boniface, Sacred Heart, and Resurrection Catholic Churches. They celebrated their 50th and 65th Wedding Anniversaries at Resurrection with their large family and friends.

He worked at Crescent Stove Works which eventually became Bootz

Manufactory Co. for 46 years. He retired after working as their plant superintendent.

Ervin was active before and after retirement with Boy Scout Troops 98 and 399. He helped several of his sons and grandsons work toward their Eagle Scout awards. He was a familiar face during scout activities and received awards himself.

He was taught to fish by his father, and he continued to share his favorite life long sport with his family and friends. Fish Fries were special family celebrations.

His wife, Margaret, preceded him in death in 2003; as well as, his daughter-in-law, Mary Lee (Schmitt) Lamble and son-in-law, Bill Cooper. Beside his parents, Joseph and Effie Lamble; his brothers: Joseph, Anton, and Leo; and sisters: Marie, Margaret, and Odelia have preceded him in death. Ervin died on March 25, 2008.
