Estella M. (Wildeman) Ubelhor, 79, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, December 30, 2009 at Deaconess Hospice Care Center.

She was born July 24, 1930 in St. Philip, IN and attended Mt. Vernon High School before graduating from Reitz Memorial High School in 1948. After high school she worked for the state of Indiana with what was then known as Crippled Children's Services. The following years were devoted to raising her large family and volunteering with groups, such as the St. Joseph School PTA and Mater Dei Band Boosters.
