Eugene Winternheimer, 85, of Wadesville, passed away Sunday, August 31, 2014 at Deaconess Hospital Main Campus. He was born in Evansville to Clarence and Leona Winternheimer.

Mr. Winternheimer had been employed at U. S. Postal Service after 25 years of service and was a lifetime farmer in the Wadesville community. He served in the U. S. Army stationed at Fort Knox during the Korean War. He was a member of the American Legion Funkhouser Post.
