Evelyn M (Deig) Meisler, age 84, of Evansville, passed away Monday, February 10, 2014 at Deaconess Hospital Main Campus, surrounded by her family.

Evelyn, along with her husband Bill, founded Meisler Cartage in 1963 in the basement of their home with just one truck.
