Fayettea L. (Benton) Lowe, 93, of Evansville, passed Wednesday, December 10, 2008 at Good Samaritan Nursing Home.

Mrs. Lowe was a homemaker for 60 years and was a member of Old Beech Church in New Harmony, Indiana. During World War II she worked as a welder at the LST Shipyards, where her father, Floyd Benton, was hired by the US Navy to serve as the welding inspector.
