Frank C. Borries, age 86, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, September 8, 2010 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Borries was a shop foreman at Bucyrus-Erie. He was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, the Knights of St. John and the St. Vincent de Paul Society at the church, Mater Dei Friends and Alumni Association and the University of Evansville Purple Aces Club. Frank was a 1942 graduate of Memorial High School and was very active in attending their monthly gatherings. He was an avid golfer, St. Louis Cardinals and Indianapolis Colts fan and never missed a Mater Dei football or basketball game or the University of Evansville basketball games. He served his country as a member of the United States Army Air Corps.

Surviving are his wife of 64 years, Marian (Small) Borries; a daughter, Christine Borries Payne of Evansville and two sons, Thomas Borries and his wife, Debbie of St. Philip, IN and Jim Borries of Evansville. Also surviving are three grandchildren, Amy Borries Wilson and Paul and Blair Borries and six great grandchildren.

Frank was preceded in death by his nine brothers and sisters.
