Frederick A. King, 92, died February 25, 2017 in Fort Smith, Arkansas. He was born in Evansville, Indiana on December 25, 1924. He was a member of Christ the King Catholic Church in Fort Smith. He was a veteran of World War II, member of the Disabled American Veterans Association and was a recipient of the Purple Heart. He worked in management at Whirlpool in Evansville and was transferred to Fort Smith in 1966. He retired after 30 years of service in 1984. He was a Notre Dame and Razorback fan and loved to fish.
