Gary R. Marx, age 64, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, August 13, 2013 at his home surrounded by his family after a yearlong battle with cancer.

Gary had retired from for the United States Postal Service after 30 years as a mail carrier. He was a veteran of the United States Army, serving during the Vietnam War. Gary earned two Purple Hearts for his service to his country. He was a member of the Riverbend Association, was an avid golfer, enjoyed spending time with his cat, Tag and loved bird watching, especially humming birds.

Surviving Gary are a daughter and her husband, Tamra Marx and Tim Eckels of Evansville; a stepson, Kelly Nace of San Diego, CA; sister, Janet Marx of Evansville and two brothers and their wives, Steve and Linda and Mike and Doris Marx, both of Evansville.
