Gene Dale “Geno” Hollencamp, 74, of Evansville, passed away at his home on Tuesday, December 26, 2023.

Geno was born on January 15, 1949 in Evansville to the late Jack and Martha (Walters) Hollencamp. He was a graduate of FJ Reitz High School and served as a medic in the United States Army in Vietnam. He owned and operated several businesses during his lifetime, including the New Village Inn in Newburgh and a convenience store in Snow Shoe, West Virginia.
