Gerald Joseph "Jerry" Bauer, 83, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, November 1, 2020 at Select Specialty Hospital.

Jerry was born October 7, 1937 in Evansville to the late Anthony and Cecilia (Gottman) Bauer. Jerry was a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel and worked for Whirlpool Corporation for over 39 years before retiring as a General Supervisor.
