Gerald Louis Hartmann, 73, of rural Evansville, passed away unexpectedly at his home on Tuesday, March 27, 2018.

Gerald was born May 19, 1944 in Mt. Vernon, IN to the late Ollie and Rosella (Harney) Hartmann. He was a member of Plumbers and Steamfitters Local #136, St. Philip Catholic Church and the St. Philip Conservation Club. Jerry served as a member of the United States Army Reserve, as an EMT with Marrs Township Fire Department and also as a troop leader for Boy Scout Troop #397.
