Glendal R. Stork, 87, formerly of Evansville, passed away on Friday, December 20, 2024 at Harrison's Crossing Health Campus in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Glendal was born in Huntingburg, Indiana on June 30, 1937 to the late August D. and Irma Kathryn (Brown) Stork. Glendal worked as a funeral director for over fifty years. He had owned and operated his own funeral home in Aurora, Indiana before retiring from Pierre Funeral Home after almost 20 years of service to the Evansville community. While living in Aurora, Glendal was a Mason and a member of Masonic Lodge #51, the Scottish Rite, the Aurora Rotary Club and the Life Squad; serving the community of Aurora. years, Nancy Sue (Heinlin) Stork in 2022; by a brother, Wayne Stork; son-in-law, Don McBride and great grandson, Cole Hansell.

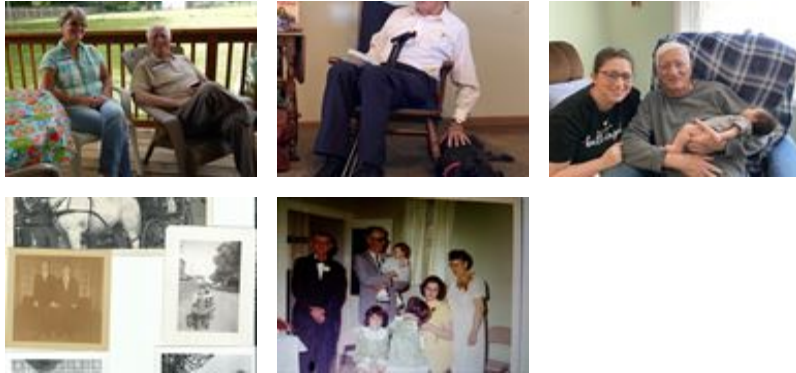

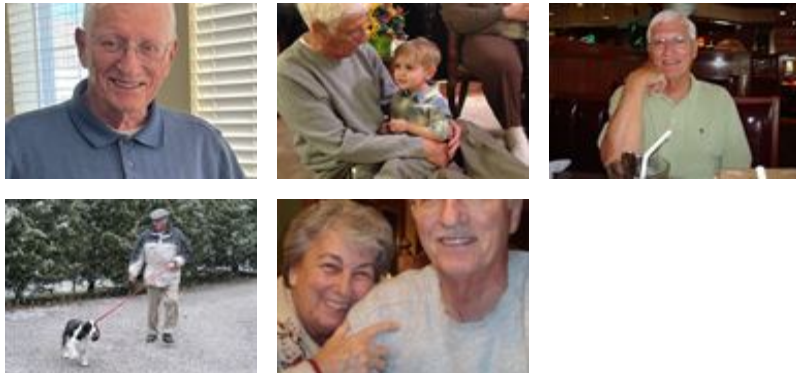
