Gloria Ann (Hilborn) Mockobee, 59, of Wadesville, passed away Sunday, April 12, 2020 at her home surrounded by loved ones.

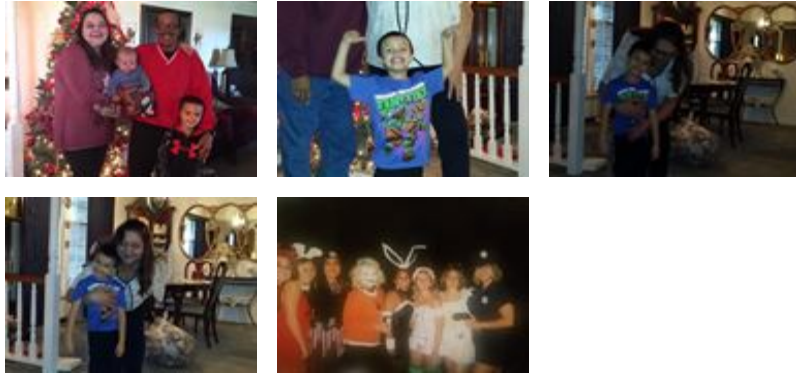

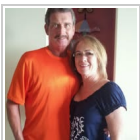
