Harold Joseph “Jake” Orth, 82, of St. Wendel, Indiana, passed away peacefully at his home on Friday, September 22, 2023 surrounded by family.

Jake was born on January 10, 1941 in St. Wendel, Indiana, to the late Jacob and Louise (Rexing) Orth. He served as a specialist in the United States Army for three years and then was discharged into the Army Reserves. In 1962, he married the love of his life, Betty Schultheis. In 1963, they moved to Texas where he worked at Manesco Manufacturing Company which specialized in the development and manufacturing of aircraft landing gear. He and his wife, Betty, owned and operated Majestic Tool, Inc. for 40 years, where he designed and built specialized machinery.
