



## Harry G McCullough

August 18, 1923 - January 19, 2015

Harry G. McCullough, age 91, of Evansville, passed away Monday, January 19, 2015 at his home surrounded by family.

Harry was born August 18, 1923 in Evansville, IN to the late Harry G. McCullough and Lillian (Stanley) McCullough Rambo. Harry and his wife Mary were charter members of Corpus Christi Catholic Church where they were very active for many years. Harry was also a lifetime member of the choir at Corpus Christi. He served in the United States Navy in the South Pacific during World War II. After serving his country, Harry returned to Evansville to wed the love of his life, the former Mary Naas and to start their life and family together. Their family grew into six children.

Harry founded H.G. McCullough Designers out of his home in 1948, growing the business throughout his lifetime before retiring at the age of 81. Harry left behind a legacy that will be remembered by all of those who had the honor of knowing him. He lived a life full of kindness and loved his family more than anything in the world. Harry will be missed by so many, but his life will be celebrated. He left with us a lifetime of memories to cherish and we will carry him in our hearts forever.

In addition to his parents, Harry was preceded in death by his brothers, Bill, Wilfred and Bob McCullough.

Harry is survived by his wife of 68 years, Mary (Naas) McCullough; children, Pete (Vera) McCullough, Tom (Pam) McCullough, Geralyn (Kent) Ruminer, Bill (Tammy) McCullough, John (Tina) McCullough and Julie (Glenn) Conley; nineteen grandchildren, four great grandchildren, nieces and nephews.
