Harvey A. Klenck, 78, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, February 29, 2020 at his home.

Harvey was born on February 9, 1942 in Martin Station, IN to the late Harold and Esther (Schmitt) Klenck. He founded H. A. Klenck Masonry in 1976. Harvey was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County, a member of the West Side Nut Club and contributed to some of the first homes built for Habitat for Humanity. He enjoyed spending time at Lake Barkley, Kentucky Dam Village and spending time with his golfing buddies.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years, Carol R. (Fehrenbacher) Klenck; his three children, Amy, Chad and Tim (Angie), all of Evansville; one sister, Mary Ellen (Roger) Ziliak, eight grandchildren, Emily (Stephen) Schnapf, Eric (Morgan) Tenbarga, Aleksey, Benjamin, Seth, Sydney, Edie and Louis Klenck and three great grandchildren, Braxton, Brinley and Maverick.

In addition to his parents, Harvey was preceded in death by two brothers, James and Verner Klenck.


