Henry M. "Hank" Preske, age 89, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, April 10, 2016 at Deaconess Hospital.

Hank was born July 6, 1926 in Evansville to the late Felix and Mary (Kissel) Preske. He worked as a sheet metal worker with United Sheet Metal Workers Local #20 and worked at Preske Sheet Metal and retired from AC Tilley.
