Henry E. Weiss, 90, of Wadesville, passed away at his home on Thursday, July 14, 2022 surrounded by his loving family.

Henry was born August 9, 1931 in Evansville to the late Edward and Justina (Kiesel) Weiss. He was a lifelong farmer; a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church and a 1st degree, 2nd degree, 3rd degree, Noble and Honorable member of the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel. 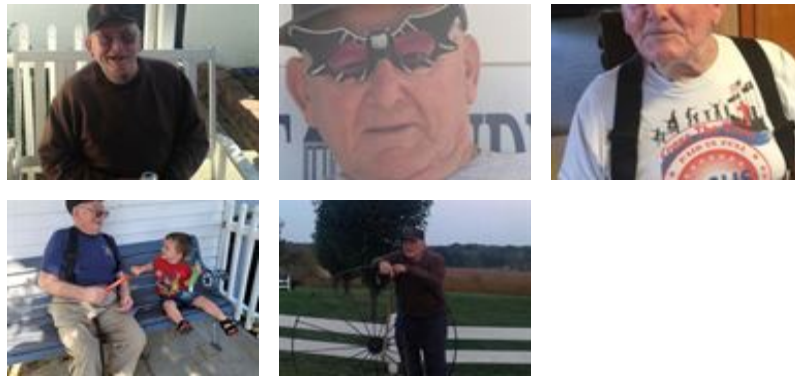

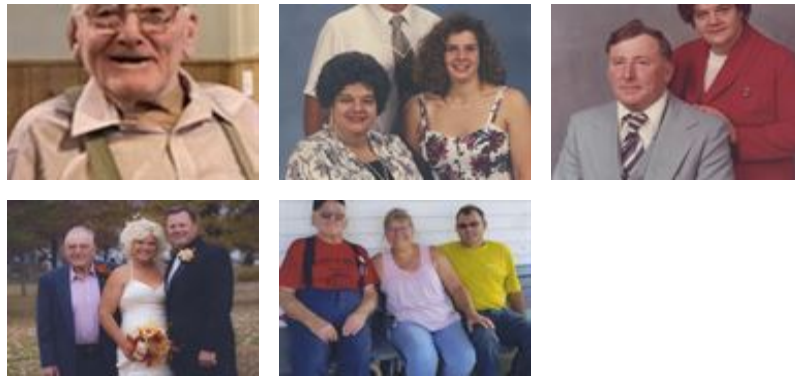
