Herbert Leroy Ohlrogge, 86, of Whiteland, IN, formerly of Evansville, passed away Friday, May 26, 2017 at Kindred Transitional Care in Greenwood, IN.

Herb was born June 24, 1930 in Merrill, WI to the late Harry and Gertrude Ohlrogge. He was a veteran of the United States Army serving during the Korean War. He was the owner and operator of Rem-X Office Supplies and after retiring from Rem-X worked for Wal-Mart for 15 years. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army from 1947 until 1954. He served in Korea where he was wounded in 1953 and received a Purple Heart. He was a member of VFW in Whiteland, IN and also VFW Post 6978 in Evansville.
