



Herman Eickhoff

March 15, 1924 - August 6, 2010

Herman J. Eickhoff, 86, of St. Philip, passed away Friday, August 6, 2010 at Deaconess Hospital.

Herman was a member of St. Philip Catholic Church, the Men's Club at the church, the St. Philip Conservation Club and a life member of VFW Post # 1114. He was one of the founding members and volunteers of the Marris Township Volunteer Fire Department. Herman served in the U. S. Army and was a prisoner of war during World War II.

He was employed as a carpenter at Fisher Woodworking before retiring in 1989.

Herman is survived by his wife of 60 years, Evelyne (Mercker) Eickhoff, one daughter, Julienne Eickhoff of Evansville and one son, Donald Eickhoff of Indianapolis. Also surviving are two brothers, Jim Eickhoff of St. Wendel and Charlie Eickhoff of Evansville; two step sisters, Flora Wolf of Evansville and Leona Sturm of San Bernardino, CA; two step brothers, Andrew and Paul Wildemann, both of St. Philip; two grandchildren, Theodore Rutherford and Benjamin Eickhoff and twenty six nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Paul and Elmer Eickhoff.

Funeral services will begin at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, August 10, 2010 at St. Philip Catholic Church, Rev. Tom Kessler officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

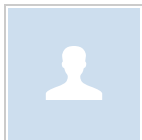
