Herman L. Frankenger, age 89, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, September 22, 2013 at Deaconess Hospital surrounded by his family.

Mr. Frankenger worked as a car salesman for Cooke Chevrolet, Kenny Kent Chevrolet and O'Daniel Ranes dealerships before retiring in 1989. He was a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church. Herman was a veteran of the United States Army, serving as a combat engineer during World War II and was a member of VFW Post #1114.
