Herman J. Schmitt, 90, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, October 20, 2024 at the Linda E. White Hospice House.

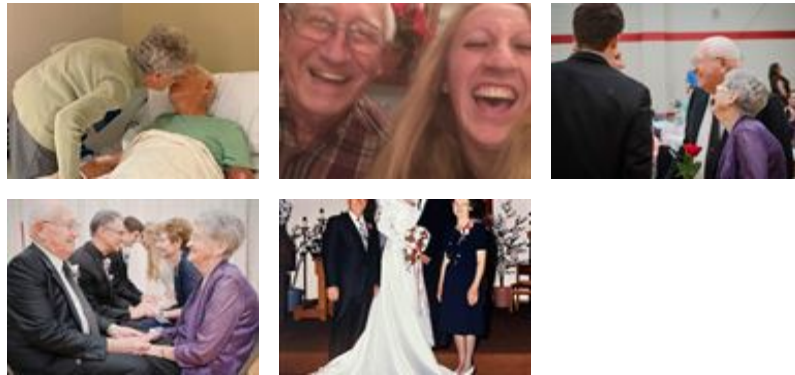
