February 1, 1935 - September 1, 2011

James R. "Jim" Seibert, age 76, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, September 01, 2011 peacefully at his residence.

Jim was born February 1, 1935 in Evansville to the late Urban Benny and Vera (Hoefling) Seibert.

He was a 1953 graduate of Mater Dei High School, where he played football and wrestled. Jim and his brothers, Bob and Urban Seibert helped form the first wrestling team at Mater Dei. Jim attended Evansville College on a football scholarship and was a member of Pi Epsilon Phi Fraternity before entering the U.S. Army where he was a tank commander at Fort Hood, TX. After his honorable discharge from the Army, Jim moved to California and worked as a service technician for Sears and Roebuck for 38 years, before returning to Evansville in 1995. He was a loving husband and a good dad.
