Janet Rae Hart James, 82, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, December 5, 2020 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus.

Janet was born July 8, 1938 in Evansville to the late Clifford and Emerene (Rainey) Williams. She worked as a registered nurse at Deaconess Hospital and a longtime active member of St. Agnes Catholic Church, where she organized the parish nurses, served as the nurse for Vacation Bible School and was active in Bible Study. Janet was a member of the Red Hat Society and a Clabber Club; she served as the President of the Poplar Grove Neighborhood Association, was a member of UNOS, volunteered with ECHO Clinic, helped tutor students at St. Agnes School where she also served as a room mother. 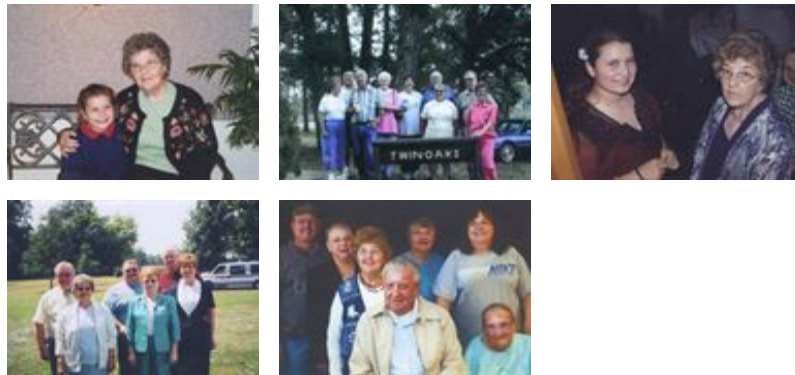
