Janet M. Spahn, 79, of Evansville, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, November 11, 2025, at the Bethel Manor Rehabilitation Cottages surrounded by her loving family.

Janet was born on October 22, 1946, in Evansville to the late Benjamin and Malinda (Pepper) Wolf. She was a devout Catholic and a faithful member of St. Wendel Catholic Church. Janet was a devoted schoolteacher and taught in the Diocese of Evansville school system and at North Elementary School in Poseyville. In the 1970s, Janet appeared on the television series *Romper Room* as Miss Janet. 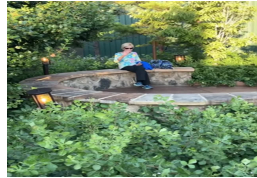
