Jarrod L. Luigs, 40, of Evansville, passed away at his home on Thursday, March 28, 2024 surrounded by his loving family.

Jarrod was born on August 19, 1983 in Evansville to Steve and Vernie (Ames) Luigs. Jarrod was a loving husband, father, son, brother and uncle. He was a devoted father to his children. He loved spending time playing outside in the yard and taking golf cart rides with them on their property. Jarrod took great pride in building the home his family lived in; had a quick wit and great sense of humor; loved traveling, grilling, hunting, working in the yard, his dog Rooney and spending time with his family and friends.
