



Jeanette Brune Knapp

September 3, 1920 - March 29, 2017

Jeanette Brune Knapp, age 96, died peacefully at the Little Sisters of the Poor, in San Pedro, California, March 29, 2017, where she had lived since August 1, 2012. Jeanette was born September 3, 1920, the third of eight children, to the late Marie B. (Olminghof) and Alois J. Brune. She and John H. Knapp married May 7, 1942. They were married 43 years until Mr. Knapp's death in 1985.
