Jeri Ann “JP” Page, 44, of Evansville, passed away peacefully at her home on Thursday, October 13, 2022.

Jeri Ann was a 1996 graduate of FJ Reitz High School and a member of the Reitz Hilltoppers. She loved to dance and started dancing at the age of four. She danced on the senior dance team for MatCats at several travel competitions; later became a cheerleader and the cheer coach for the Evansville Blue Cats indoor football team.
