Jerome W. Rexing, 92, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, February 19, 2020 at his home.

Jerry was born May 15, 1927 in Evansville to the late Anthony and Cecelia (Welte) Rexing. He worked as a tool and die maker and was a co-owner of Evansville Tool and Die. He also worked for Evana Tool and Engineering before retiring in 1990. Jerry was an active member of St. Philip Catholic Church and the St. Philip Men's Club. He was inducted into the Brute Society for his service to the church by the Diocese of Evansville. Jerry was a veteran of the United States Navy; a life member of VFW Post #1114 and American Legion Funkhouser Post 8.
