Jerome L. Muensterman, age 85, of Evansville, passed away Friday, September 3, 2010 at the Solarbron Terrace.

Mr. Muensterman was the owner of Muensterman's Service Center until his retirement in 1988. He was a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church, the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel and a life member of VFW Post# 6576 in Wadesville. Jerome served his country as a veteran of the United States Army serving in Europe during WWII. He achieved the rank of Staff Sergeant and was awarded two Bronze Stars, the Victory Medal and Good Conduct Medal.

Surviving Jerome are his wife of 62 years, Marcella (Luigs) Muensterman; a daughter and her husband, Janet and Steve Reidford of St. Philip; five sons and their wives, Tom and JoAnn Muensterman and Steve and Becky Muensterman, both of St. Joe, Jerry and Cindy Muensterman, Mark and Michelle Muensterman and Bob and Pam Muensterman, all of St. Wendel. Also surviving are twenty four grandchildren and 2 great grandchildren.

Mr. Muensterman was preceded in death by his parents, Ben and Rosa (Weidner) Muensterman; three sisters, Leona Weinzapfel, Eloise Hartman and Genevieve Stephens and a brother, Clarence Muensterman.

Funeral services will begin at 10:00 A.M. Tuesday, September 7, 2010 at St.

Wendel Catholic Church, Rev. Ed Schnur officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery where military rites will be conducted by the VFW Post #6576 in Wadesville.
