John C. Hahn, II, age 54, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, June 16, 2010 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Hahn had worked as a journeyman machinist before becoming a salesman with Kight Home Improvement Center. He was a firefighter with the Perry Township Fire Department and also served as an EMT. He had worked as a volunteer for 10 years as Vanderburgh County Special Deputy. John was a 1973 graduate of Reitz High School where he played football and ran track. He was an avid golfer and shooter, a member of the Westside Sportsmen's Club and a 20 year member of the Westside Nut Club. He was also a member of the St. Paul's United Church of Christ on Michigan Street.
