December 19, 1921 - June 14, 2009

Joseph V. Blankenberger, 87, of St. Wendel, IN passed away Sunday, June 14, 2009 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Blankenberger farmed for 45 years before his retirement. He was an ordained Deacon for the Diocese of Evansville and a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church. Joe was also a member of the Knights of St. John in St. Wendel and the St. Vincent de Paul Society. He served in the U. S. Army during World War II and was a member of VFW Post 6576 in Wadesville.

Joe is survived by his wife of 62 years, Betty A. (Hartman) Blankenberger, five daughters, Maureen A. Wysopal of Augusta, West Virginia, Mary B. Thewes of Portersville, IN, Bridget A.
