Joseph P. Head, Jr., age 90, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, April 15, 2021 at the Solarbron Terrace.

Joe was born October 25, 1930 in Evansville to the late Joseph, Sr. and Lucille Catherine (Hahn) Hofmann.
