Juanita Mae Small, resident of Parkview Care Center, passed away on November 29, 2010. Juanita, known to her family as, "Aunt Mae", was born in Midway, IN on December 3, 1917. At the age of five years, she moved to Evansville, and started classes at the old Baker School and finished at the old Vogel School. She graduated from Central High School in 1936.

Juanita worked for over 60 years; thirty years for H.A. Woods Drug Company 10 years for McLean Trucking Company and 20 years at DeJong's Department Store. During World War II she worked at the Evansville Shipyard doing her part on the home front.

She was a member of Bethel United Church of Christ and was active for many years in the Priscilla Circle. Juanita was a volunteer "Pink Lady" at Deaconess Hospital for over 25 years until she lost her eye sight.
